The divine will **substituting** the human body of Christ (forgiveness)

The divine will **sanctifying** the human heart of man (holiness)

vs. 14 – “made them perfect
forever”

vs. 17 – “sins are remembered no
more”

vs. 18 – “no more sacrifice is
needed”

When we turn away from [present] sin and ask/trust Christ to deal with the consequences of [past] sin, we can **know** with **certainty** those wrongs are **removed** from God's **record**.
