11 Cor. 5:1-5 = building, house, dwelling Rev. 6:9-11, 7:13-17 = robes 1 Cor. 15:35 ff describes a future body as spiritual/glorious, but this is speaking of the resurrected physical body suited for God's new earth. That body will never perish (42)!
