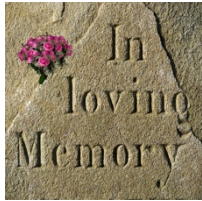


We rejoice with those who entered into Christian baptism last Sunday. In addition to those listed last week, **Pam Jones** was also baptized.
